

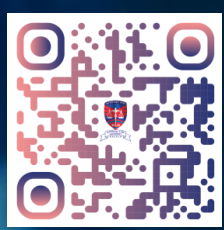

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## **About the University**

Maharashtra National Law University, Nagpur (MNLU, Nagpur) was established by the Government of Maharashtra by way of enactment known as the Maharashtra National Law University Act (Maharashtra Act No. VI of 2014). Hon'ble Shri Justice Bhushan R. Gavai, Judge, Supreme Court of India, is the Chancellor of the University. It is a residential University engaged in teaching and promoting research in law and allied disciplines. The University has a competent team of faculty and staff, who are qualified, experienced, committed, and full of zeal to create an institution of excellence in legal education in the country.

The University been recognised by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and affiliated with the Bar Council of India (BCI), and it is also a member of Association of Indian Universities (AIU). The objectives of the University are manifold: to advance and disseminate learning and knowledge of law, legal processes and their role in national development; to serve society in the field of law by developing skills in regard to advocacy, legal services, legislation, law reforms and the likes; to promote legal knowledge and to make law and legal processes efficient instruments of social justice and development; to promote traditional, cultural, legal and ethical values with a view to promote and foster the rule of law and the objectives enshrined in the Constitution of India; and to liaison with institutions of higher learning and research in India and abroad.

At present, the University is offering three Undergraduate Degree Courses and a One-Year Postgraduate Degree Course in Corporate and Commercial Laws; Intellectual Property Law and Policy; Constitutional Laws; Personal Laws; Energy and Telecommunication Laws; and Criminal Law and Forensic Sciences in addition to the Ph.D. Programme. The University has also expanded its horizon with varied field of knowledge by collaborating with various institute of excellence from diverse disciplines and introducing novel course such as B.A.LL.B.(Hons. in Adjudication and Justicing) Five-Year Degree Course, which is designed to disseminate quality justice education among the students and extend support to the justice administration system in the country.

## **About the Course**

The University is determined towards its commitment for continuous development in the field of legal and justice education with its competent and professional team of students, faculty members, administration, and collaborations. The University strives for marking its meaningful contribution towards upgrading quality of administration of justice, management of legal counselling in a firm, teaching and/or by the legal professionals. However, the University recognises that there are professionals who could not complete their higher education in Law due to professional commitments and various other reasons. Therefore, the University is offering a Non-Residential Two-Year LL.M. (Postgraduate) Degree Course on Administration of Justice for Professionals. It is an attempt to spread out the quality legal and justice education for upgrading the administration of justice in the country.

### **Eligibility**

- Three (3) years or five (5) years Bachelor's Degree in Law (LL.B./B.A.LL.B./B.A.LL.B. (Hons. in Adjudication and Justicing/BBA.LL.B.) or an equivalent degree with a minimum of fifty (50) percent marks or its equivalent grade from a recognised university/institution of higher education in case of candidates belonging to General/OBC categories and forty-five (45) percent marks or its equivalent grade from a recognised university/institution of higher education in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/SAP (PwD) categories. There shall be no upper age limit to the candidates for this degree course.
- No Upper age Limit.

### **Admission Process**

Eligible candidates shall be admitted to the course as per the merit list of the All India Entrance Test of Postgraduates Degree for Executives and Professionals (AIET-PGEP) conducted by the University.

### **Duration of the Course**

- The course is offered for a period of Two (2) years. As the University follows semester system, the course shall have its duration of four semesters.

### **Mode of Execution**

The regular classes for the course shall be conducted in hybrid mode (online and physical) on Saturdays and Sundays or Holidays. However, Seminar Papers and the Dissertation shall be supervised and conducted in physical mode only.

## **Total Number of Seats**

The total number of seats are 120. However, the University reserves the right to alter the number of seats for the course in the given academic year without prior notice.

## **Medium of Instructions**

English shall be the medium of instruction for teaching, research and examinations.

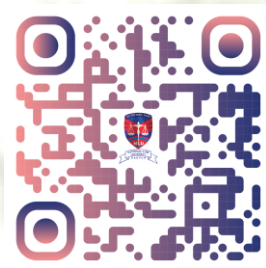
