4.	Post 5:00 p.m., June 23, 2026	No Refund

B. Only applicable for the Students who admitted through Fourth and Fifth Round(s):

1.	If the student files an application for cancellation/withdrawal of admission up to June 14, 2026 5:00 p.m.	100% Refund
2.	If the student files an application for cancellation/withdrawal of admission up to June 29, 2026 5:00 p.m.	90% Refund
3.	If the student files an application for cancellation/withdrawal of admission up to July 29, 2026 5:00 p.m.	80% Refund
4.	Post 5:00 p.m., July 29, 2026	No Refund
