1. INTRODUCTION

The Annual Report was prepared by the Executive Council regarding the working of the University in pursuance of the requirement as per Section 37 of the Maharashtra National Law University Act, 2014 for presentation before the General Council of the University for its consideration and approval as required by Section 14(3) of the Maharashtra National Law University Act, 2014. The period covered in this report is the financial year from April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021. The University commenced its academic session for the odd Semesters on June 8, 2020 for semesters III, V, VII of B.A.LL.B.(Hons.) Five-Year Integrated Degree Course and classes for Semester-I of Undergraduate and Postgraduate Degree Courses on October 19, 2020. End Semester Examinations were conducted between November 1-8, 2020. The even semester commenced on January 4, 2021. During (winter) semester break, students went for the internships.

The University received the BCI final letter no. BCI;D;272/2020(LE-F/std.22/23/. 22/23/24.6.2018) dated March 03, 2020 after confirmation/ratification by the Legal Education Committee and General Council of the Bar Council of India with regard to earlier letter BCI;D;882/2018(LE/std. 22/23/24.6.2018) dated July 10, 2018 relating to recignition and fresh approval to the University to impart Five-Year Integrated Degree Course i.e., B.A.LL.B.(Hons.) with an intake of two sections of 60 students each for a period of two years i.e., for the academic years 2018-19 and 2019-20.

6.2 Admissions to B.A.LL.B.(Honours in Adjudication and Justicing) Five-Year Integrated Degree Course for the academic year 2020-21

The University launched the first-of-its-kind new course *viz.*, B.A.LL.B.(Honours in Adjudication and Justicing). The University issued a notification to this effect on November 2, 2020, and 156 applications were received till 11:59 p.m. on November 19, 2020 which was the last date for receipt of applications. Admissions to this Course have been done through CLAT-2020 based first stage shortlisting followed by a Psychometric Test conducted Online on November 26, 2020, and a second stage shortlisting through Group Discussion conducted Online on November 27, 2020, and Personal Interviews conducted Online on 29-30, 2020.

Aspiring Minds, a company experienced in conducting Psychometric Tests, was hired for the said test. Group Discussions were conducted by two panels with one member from the University in each panel, while Mr. Rajiv Kumar Luv and Mr. Vivek Patki from M.R. Pia foundation, Mumbai; and Prof. (Dr.) N.Y. Phadnis and Dr. Seema Singh from IMT Nagpur were invited as external members. Group Discussion was an elimination round and the shortlisted candidates appeared for Personal Interview. For the Personal Interview, following four external Panel Members were invited:

- 1) Hon'ble Shri Justice Rohit Deo, Judge, Bombay High Court, Bench at Nagpur;
- 2) Hon'ble Shri Justice Manish Pitale, Judge, Bombay High Court, Bench at Nagpur;
- 3) Mrs. Kartika Jamdar, Psychologist;
- 4) Prof. (Dr.) Vijender Kumar, Vice Chancellor; and
- 5) Dr. Varsha Deshpande, Associate Professor of Law.

Based on personal interview, the first merit list was released on December 01, 2020 and 40 (Forty) candidates took admission through the first merit list itself. Further, the University has requested for approval of the Bar Council of India for the said course vide Letter No. MNLUN/VC/2020/52 dated November 5, 2020.
