ANNUAL REPORT OF MAHARASHTRA NATIONAL LAW UNIVERSITY, NAGPUR FOR THE PERIOD FROM APRIL 1, 2017 TO MARCH 31, 2018

1. INTRODUCTION

The Annual Report was prepared by the Executive Council on working of the University in pursuance of the requirement as per Section 37 of the Maharashtra National Law University Act, 2014 for presentation before the General Council of the University for its consideration and approval as required by Section 14(3) of the Maharashtra National Law University Act, 2014. The period covered in this report is the financial year from April 1, 2017 to March 31, 2018. The University commenced its academic session on January 9, 2017, End semester Examinations were over on May 6, 2017 and result was declared on May 12, 2017. The next semester was commenced on July 3, 2017, End Semester Examinations were over on November 11, 2017 and result was declared on November 24, 2017. During (summer and winter) semester breaks, students went for the internships.

The Vice-Chancellor conducted a series of meetings on academic and infrastructural requirements with internal committees, faculty members and students as well as external agencies and government departments. The authorities of the University are also making best possible efforts to bring up state-of-the-art facilities at the University.

The University is empowered, vide letter no. F. 9-5/2017 (CPP-l/PU) Dated- June 14, 2017 by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under Section 2(f) of the University Grants Commission Act 1956, to award academic degrees as specified under Section 22 of the UGC Act.

The Governing Council of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), vide letter no. Meet/GC/345 Dated- July 7, 2017, granted provisional membership of AIU to MNLU, Nagpur w.e.f., June 7, 2017 for three years extendable by two years, within which the University is required to fulfil the eligibility to obtain permanent membership after due inspection from AIU.

The University has applied to the Bar Council of India on August 1, 2017 for seeking approval of affiliation and recognition of University as a Centre of Legal Education. The BCI Inspection Team inspected the University, on January 30, 2018.

6.3. Ph.D. Degree Programme

The University conducted All India Entrance Test (AIET)-2017 on August 13, 2017 at Nagpur Centre. A total of 49 applications (12 in the category of exempted and 37 in the category non-exempted applicants) were received. 30 candidates appeared for the AIET-2017 and 11 candidates successfully cleared the AIET-2017. Those candidates who have cleared the AIET-2017 and those who were exempted (in total 23) were asked to submit the Preliminary Proposal. All the candidates were asked to appear before the Research Committee on October 27, 2017 for an Interaction on the Preliminary Proposal.

The Research Committee met on October 27, 2017, out of 23 candidates only 19 candidates appeared for the interaction and presentation of their Preliminary Proposal. After going through the Preliminary Proposals and the Presentations, the Research Committee asked the Candidates to submit a revised Preliminary Proposal after incorporating the suggestions.

The revised Preliminary Proposals were submitted by the candidates on November 8, 2017. The revised Preliminary Proposals were thoroughly screened and after Interaction with the Research Committee 15 (Fifteen) Candidates were allowed to take provisional admission to the Ph.D. Course Work. 13 (Thirteen) Candidates have taken admission. The University conducted an Orientation Programme on January 6, 2018 to the Provisionally admitted Ph.D. scholars.

The Internal Committee after going through various models of Course Work, designed a draft Course Work and presented the same to the Research Committee in its meeting held on February 8, 2018. The Research Committee has gone through the Draft Couse Work and approved the same for implementation.

6.3.1 Orientation of First Batch of Ph.D. Programme





The Orientation programme for the scholars was organised by the University on January 6, 2018 wherein Prof. (Dr.) Ranbir Singh, Vice-Chancellor, National Law University Delhi was the Chief Guest, Prof. (Dr.) Paramjit S. Jaswal, Vice-Chancellor of Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Punjab (Patiala) was the Guest of Honour and Prof. (Dr.) Vijender Kumar, Vice-Chancellor of the University presided over the programme. Prof. Kumar welcomed the guests and scholars and observed that the scholars are fortunate enough as their orientation is done by two eminent academicians in the field of legal education. Prof. Singh advised the scholars that for doing research for Ph.D. Degree, a scholar must be focused, committed to the research, and must develop 'Critical Legal Thinking'.
